Monthly Operational Report -- August 2011

Ambulance Deployment

- Repositioned a unit to Ft. White Fire Station for increased coverage area with an anticipated full-time placement in September
- Introduced a Dynamic Deployment Model to decrease the amount of time a patient waits for an ambulance
- Installed GPS devices in the ambulances

Job Creation:

- Added 4 full-time employees
- Added 6 part-time employees
- Added a training coordinator, dedicated to continued education and training of employees



Continued Education:

- Advanced Airway Management
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support
- Advanced Medical Life Support
- Pre-Hospital Trauma Support
- Training Classes with Shands Lake Shore Regional Medical Center and Lake City Medical Center

Response Time:

- Combined Average- Rural & Urban:
8 minutes, 50 seconds
- Increased ambulance coverage has resulted in a dependency on mutual aid of *less than 1%*
